


SANDWICH PROGRAM NEWSLETTER WEEK 1

SANDWICH PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Thank you for choosing to have your child participate in the Conway Parks and Recreation Department Sandwich programs in the months of November and December 2021. We are thrilled to be offering in person programing once again.

Arrival: Participants should arrive 5 minutes prior to their scheduled activity if being transported by a parent or guardian. Please enter the Conway Parks and Recreation entrance located on the back side of the main building. Participants who choose to take advantage of the recreation bus from Pine Tree or use the in person pick up from Conway Elementary School will be brought directly to the gym or arts and crafts room. Please note if you are using these services, please send your child with a note to use this service. Per federal guidelines, masks are required while on the rec bus.

Participation: Equipment used will be sanitized frequently. At the end of each session all equipment borrowed or used must be returned and will be fully sanitized by Recreation staff. There will be multiple hand sanitizing stations, however we do recommend each participant has their own as well.

Participants should bring their own water bottle filled, we will not be supplying water.

Masks are recommended but not required in the Conway Parks and Recreation Department building.

Conclusion: Participants in the arts and crafts program can check out their child at the main office desk at 5:30 p.m. Participants in the indoor soccer program should be picked up inside the Marshall Gymnasium at 4:45 p.m. Parents are welcome to enter the gym early and watch if they choose. Please follow signage to exit the building (we have other programs running and do not want to expose multiple groups to each other).

Please do not attend if you or your child has any symptoms of Covid-19. Please also observe and respect all quarantines put in place by the school or community. Your cooperation with this allows us to continue to offer in person programs safely here at the Conway Parks and Recreation Department.
