All those who are registered for Early Drop off and Late Pick up must remember that your child needs to be picked up no later than 5:00 p.m. Our staff members who need to stay for supervision may have other jobs that they need to go to. We ask that you respect their responsibilities to other positions.

If your child is still here after 5:00 p.m. they will be supervised but understand you may be charged an additional fee for this time. We are sorry that this has become something we need to address , but it is an issue none the less.
