Ice Skating at the Ham Arena

This program is for 3rd through 6th graders. It will start Monday November 3rd and run each Monday until December 1st. We will skate from 3:30 – 4:45 p.m. Kids will be picked up at school and walked to the Ham Arena. The cost of this program is \$10.00. (To be a participant your child must have his or her own helmet for safety) Helmets are not provided or rentable at the rink. Pick-up at the end of the day will take place at the Ham Arena.

Pickleball

For 3rd through 5th graders and will be held on Tuesdays and Fridays 3:30-4:30 p.m. here at the Rec. This program starts Friday, November 14th and runs through Friday, December 5th. (Please note there is no Pickleball the week of Thanksgiving). We will pick up the kids at after school on these days and walk them to the Rec. The cost of this program is \$12.00.

Bowling

This program is for Kindergarten through 2nd grade. This program will start Wednesday, November 5th and run every Wednesday to December 3rd.
