# **Program Notes**

Grade 3-4 Soccer has played two games to this point. The team stands with a record of one win and one loss, with a great effort in a 1-0 loss at Lovell last week and a 5-1 victory over Fryeburg this past Wednesday. There are no games next week as the Fair is in town.

Our 5-6 Soccer team is also sporting a record of one win and one loss as they opened with a hard fought, well played 2-1 defeat at the hands of a strong Lovell team. They rebounded with a solid 4-1 victory in Fryeburg last Monday. The result of tonight's game was not known at press time! We will have practices next week, but again, due to the Fair there will be no games.

Field Hockey has started strong with victories in both of their games. The first was against Fryeburg on Monday and then the second was against Ossipee on Wednesday. Field Hockey does have games scheduled during the Fair week as we travel to Madison on Monday for a 5:00 p.m. game and Wednesday to Ossipee for a 4:30 game.

Flag Football got underway last Thursday with all six teams in action. The Packers opened the night by beating the Chargers 32-16. That was followed by the Bengals defeating the Dolphins 25 -15. In the final game of the night, the Colts fell to the Cowboys by a score of 26-6. Due to the weather, action was unable to resume this week. Those postponed games will be moved to later in the season and made up then. There will be practices on Tuesday of next week but there are no games or practices on Thursday.

Biddy Soccer will continue to have it's two session this Saturday the 28th. However, they will not meet on Saturday the 5th of Oct. as we will concede to the Fair on this day. Sessions will pick back up on Saturday, Oct 12th and finish on October 19th.

Biddy Field Hockey will meet on Tuesday, Oct. 1st as that program is going hot and heavy and does not want to slow down! Two weeks remain and Tuesday, Oct. 8th will be their final day.

Our final two programs of the Fall will be coming to a close today for Pond Hockey and Monday for Cross Country. We would like to thank all those involved in both those programs as participants and volunteers. Both were a big hit this Fall and we are very happy with the enthusiasm shown by all the kids and our helpers.

# Field Hockey Program Update

Due to our larger than expected registration numbers for this year's girls Field Hockey program, the Conway Parks & Recreation Department has decided to implement an Intramural concept to accommodate the large numbers and give all participants the best experience possible.

In the past we have had one team and all girls participated in games. With 34 girls registered in the program this season it is not feasible to manage that many participants at one game. Therefore, we have decided that on the days of scheduled games we will have a group that plays in the game and those not on the roster will have intramural games here onsite during regular practice time. Our intent is to have the kids playing instead of watching.

Obviously, this is new to everyone and we will have growing pains. We appreciate your support and understanding while we work out all the wrinkles. The roster for our current schedule will be made up of our 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders with a couple of 4<sup>th</sup> graders filling out the roster on these days. The remaining participants in the program will have practice/intramural games at the regular 3:30 p.m. time. We are also in the process of scheduling games with others towns for just our grade 3-4 group.
