Field Hockey Program Update

Due to our larger than expected registration numbers for this year's girls Field Hockey program, the Conway Parks & Recreation Department has decided to implement an Intramural concept to accommodate the large numbers and give all participants the best experience possible.

In the past we have had one team and all girls participated in games. With 34 girls registered in the program this season it is not feasible to manage that many participants at one game. Therefore, we have decided that on the days of scheduled games we will have a group that plays in the game and those not on the roster will have intramural games here onsite during regular practice time. Our intent is to have the kids playing instead of watching.

Obviously, this is new to everyone and we will have growing pains. We appreciate your support and understanding while we work out all the wrinkles. The roster for our current schedule will be made up of our 5th and 6th graders with a couple of 4th graders filling out the roster on these days. The remaining participants in the program will have practice/intramural games at the regular 3:30 p.m. time. We are also in the process of scheduling games with others towns for just our grade 3-4 group. It is important that you check the weekly newsletter and your e-mail regularly for updates on game day rosters.
