WHAT TO EXPECT

The first day of the Grade 2-3 Co-ed program will include all the players registered attending the first practice at 3:45p.m. This will be an hour long and will introduce the kids to the court and the basket height along with the expectations of what we want to achieve. They will get their team assignments and schedules again just in case they missed them . The game jerseys will be handed out before their first games on Monday, Dec 9th.

The 4-6 grade boys will have their first full team practice on Wednesday the 4th. The practice times are split so that each team can have half the court to practice on. So we have two teams at 3:30 p.m. and then two more at 4:30 p.m. We have tried to mix up the practice times as best we could. We may still have some roster moves that may have to be made if we pick up or lose any players during this time. Also, once rosters are finalized we will then order the games jerseys so that they are here before the first game in January.

Likewise, the grade 4-6 girls will have the same situation on the day they practice. They will split the gym and have just one time slot for that day. Same procedures will apply for rosters and jerseys as well.

The actual game schedule will be handed out to all teams at their first practices. Please note right now that the Game Day is always Tuesdays. We start the first Tuesday in January and play every Tuesday after that until February Vacation. The practice day will remain the same for each program. So you have just two days of basketball per week. We hope this allows everyone to participate in conjunction with the many others things kids are involved in.
